Blood Banks to be upgraded to Model Blood Banks

- NACO equipments to 16 Model BBs in AP, Chandigarh, Delhi, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, J&K, Karnataka, Kerala, Manipur, Pondicherry, TN, Tripura, UP & WB will be supplied in 2nd quarter of 10-11. Equipments for remaining sites in Orissa, Punjab, HP, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Nagaland & Delhi to be supplied by end of 10—11
- Government notification to designate the BBs a Model BB and nominate the Medical Officer In Charge as Director of the Model BB with a copy marked to NACO
- Constitution of a TOT for each of the new Model Blood Banks comprising 2-3 Experts to impart training (Names to be sent to NACO by the end of June,2010).
